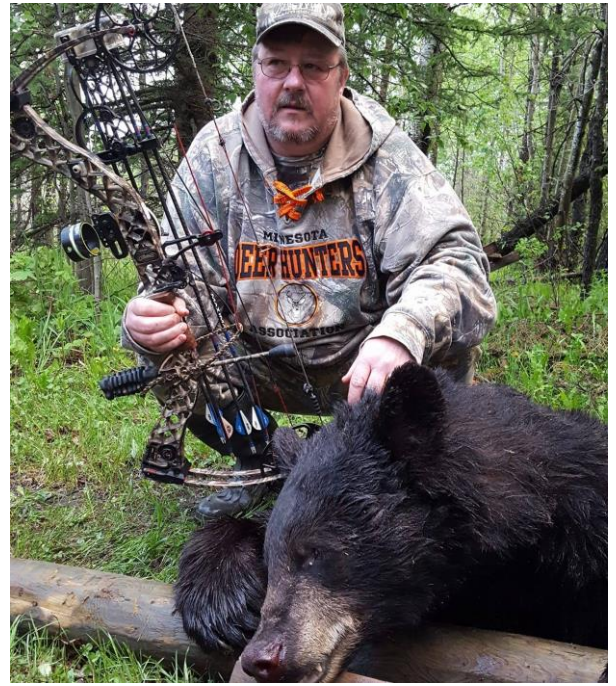


## 2022 Happenings
